

Vendor Rules & Guidelines

Registration and payment must be received together by the event-specific deadline date to reserve your spot. Registration and payment can be submitted together—either online or via mail. Payments are non-refundable.

Merchandise for sale must be items that are authentically made by the vendor who will be present at the show. Store bought items, mass-manufactured items, catalog-ordered items, or imported articles are prohibited. Photographs of items being crafted by the vendor may be required as a part of vendor's registration. The event committee reserves the right to prohibit any merchandise which is questionable in nature. Vendor is responsible for collecting any applicable taxes. The event sponsor will not be responsible for any missing or damaged products.

Vendors may not share booth space for the purpose of reducing registration fees. Load-in must be completed by the event opening time and load-out should not begin until the end of event. Booths must be attended at all times and staffed by an individual over the age of 18 until the event close. Vendors ensure that there are not disruptions emitting from their booth and must not block aisle ways in any manner.

Edible items may only be sold if they are packaged & intended to be consumed off premises and seller follow the local food safety regulations.

Political election campaign booths are not permitted.

Pets are not allowed unless they are a certified support animal.

Use of open flame for any purpose is prohibited.
