The **Student Art Contest & Exhibit** is a free contest sponsored by the Tipp City Area Arts Council—to encourage creativity, imagination and fun! Artwork should align with this year’s challenge, **“Give Peace A Chance.”** The **Student Art Exhibit** can be viewed between March 4–March 15 at Randall Residence, located at 6400 S. County Road 24A, Tipp City, OH, during normal business hours. The **Reception and Awards Ceremony** will be held on March 8, at the Randall Residence. (See *information below.*)

eligibility

Artwork that does not meet ALL criteria below will not be accepted.

- 👉 Open to students in Tipp City and neighboring communities.
- 👉 Art must be student’s original concept, design and execution.
 - NOTE NO** artificial intelligence (AI) generated or enhanced content will be accepted.
- 👉 Art can be 2D or 3D, color or black and white, and can be created in any media—including drawings, paintings, digital photography, sculpture, mixed media, textile arts, etc. (**NO** glitter, sand, etc.—Chalk must be sprayed with fixative.)
 - NOTE** Students may submit computer-generated art but it will not be eligible for awards.
- 👉 Artwork should be framed (wire or sawtooth hanger), matted or mounted on poster board.
- 👉 2-dimensional artwork should be no larger than 16 x 20 inches (not including frame).

categories

Grades K-1 • Grades 2-3 • Grades 4-5 • Grades 6-7 • Grades 8-9 • Grades 10-12

Artwork will be judged by committee and winners will be chosen in each category.

(The committee reserves the right to adjust categories as necessary and will accept up to the first 100 pieces, as space allows.)

TEACHERS. No class sets please, as space is limited. **NEW** Preschoolers may submit framed art for display but it will not be judged.)

deadline

Artwork may be submitted February 26–March 1 at Tipp Monroe Community Services, 3 E Main Street, Tipp City, OH, between the hours of 8am–5pm. Artwork not received by 5pm on March 1 will be ineligible.

reception & awards

A **Reception & Awards Ceremony** will be held on **March 8** at Randall Residence, 6400 S. County Road 25A, Tipp City, OH, at 6:00pm, with awards handed out at 6:30pm.
