



history

"Windows on Tippecanoe"—held in the summer of 2008—was the vision of community member Ellen Cotterman. Area artists donated original artwork which was mounted in old window frames and hung collectively on a downtown building. In October 2008, a gala was held and the artwork was sold via an auction. The revenue and enthusiasm generated by this event was the genesis of the Tipp City Art Arts Council.

provides area artists an opportunity to showcase and sell their work.

- Artists will choose their window frame and create their art. *Frames have been donated by Heather Bailey and Frank Scenna.*
- Artists determine whether their artwork will be available for purchase and establish a purchase price.
- Art will be displayed in downtown Tipp City businesses during the month of June 2021.
- Art will be displayed and available for purchase in an online gallery hosted by TCAAC. *TCAAC will receive a 10% commission on all art sold.*

registration NOVEMBER–DECEMBER 2020

- Artists must register no later than December 15, 2020 through the TCAAC website at www.tippcityartscouncil.com/windows and submit the \$10 non-refundable registration fee.
- Artists must take their registration receipt to **Midwest Memories** (24 W Main Street, Tipp City, OH) no later than December 15, 2020, during normal business hours, to select and pick up their window frame. Selection will be on a "first-come, first-serve" basis.

submission MAY 2021

- Artists will have from December 2020 through May 2021 to complete their artwork.
- Artwork must be submitted to **Midwest Memories** (24 W Main Street, Tipp City, OH) between May 1–May 31, 2021 during normal store hours.
- TCAAC will distribute submitted artwork to participating locations in June 2021 for public display.

art show JUNE 2021

- The **WINDOWS ON MAIN—THE RETURN** art show will be promoted by the TCAAC via our website, social media, etc.
- Artwork can be viewed in person at participating locations between June 1–June 30, 2021. Locations will be posted on our website at www.tippcityartscouncil.com/windows.
- Artwork can be viewed and purchased online at any time during the month of June 2021—but will remain on display until the end of the June.
- The physical art show will end on June 30, 2021. The TCAAC will collect all art and arrange delivery to artists and/or purchasers in July 2021.
